

CT Guided Biopsy

Description: CT Guided Biopsy- Computed Tomography (CT) scan use a special x-ray machine to take detailed pictures of the body's organs and tissues. In a biopsy a small piece of tissue is removed from your body. This tissue sample is the examined in the lab. A needle biopsy is the safest and easiest way to remove this tissue from your body.

Prep instructions: Nothing to eat or drink eight hours prior to appointment. Current labs within 30 days of procedure, address blood thinning meds with ordering physician or anticoagulation clinic.

Post instructions: You must have a driver and caregiver at the time of discharge. You should not operate any machinery or make any important decisions for 24 hours after sedation. Follow up with ordering physician for results.
