Free Dial-a-Ride program for residents of Sun City

(623) 933-7530

Qualified applicants will reside in Sun City, be over 65 year or older or disabled, not own a car, and meet low income criteria not to exceed \$1,437 for single household, or \$1,940 for two-person household. Each eligible person will get \$50 of free Dial-a-Ride tickets mailed to them 4x/year.

You can obtain discounted taxi vouchers through this program. In some circumstances dialysis patients can obtain with free rides to and from their home to the closest dialysis center.

Dial A Ride (Phoenix)

Call the number above to initiate referral process. \$4 a ride. They are able to provide transportation to those with power scooters.

Phoenix VA Health Care System DAV shuttle

Morning appointments only, call several days in advance to reserve seat. Can't accommodate wheel chair or power scooter. Must live within the City of Phoenix.

Disabled American Veterans

Provides free rides to and from VAMC

City of Phoenix Taxi Subsidy Program

Provides subsidized taxi vouchers to eligible seniors 65 years and older.

Scottsdale Cab Connections Subsidy Program

480-312-8747

Provides subsidized taxi vouchers for eligible seniors for taxi rides from Scottsdale to anywhere in the Valley. Eligible dialysis patients can receive up to 26 free vouchers.

City of Glendale Taxi Subsidy Program

Providers taxi subsidy for repetitive medical treatments (i.e., dialysis, cancer treatments, therapy post stroke, etc.)

Elite Medical Transport - 480-234-0158

Offers a ride and escort service to medical appointments for disabled riders and seniors.

Requires one day advance notice

Able to accommodate electric wheelchair/scooter

Cost is \$45 pickup plus \$3 per mile- round trip

Requires one day advance notice

Able to accommodate electric wheelchair/scooter

Cost is \$35 per hour (1-hour minimum)

App Capable Transportation

Lyft

On demand rides available at cost per mile.

Additionally, through a program- "Relief Ride" eligible Veterans and other low-income riders may be eligible for free transport to medical appointments, job interviews. Veterans will be required to verify his/her military status through the Lyft.

Lyft can accommodate wheelchair transport needs. To enable specialty transport access mode:

1. Tap the menu icon in the top left corner
2. Scroll down and tap 'Settings'
3. Find 'Wheelchair access' in the menu
4. Slide the toggle to the right so it's green
5. Type in your destination, then swipe left to see additional mode
6. Tap "More" then tap "Access" to select wheelchair mode
7. Tap "Request Access," confirm your pickup location, and you're all set!

Uber

On demand rides available at cost per mile.

Special rates may apply to eligible Veterans. To verify military status in the in the Uber app:

1. Select account from the driver app menu, then select Settings.
2. Select affiliations, then tap Verify (next to Military).
3. Rider's mobile device web browser will open ID.me to verify military status using ID.me a third-party verification services.
4. After ID.me successfully verifies military affiliation, rider will be redirected back to the rider app's settings menu to choose whether rider's military affiliation to other riders for shared rides.
